## CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS AND LINE PRODUCTION, SEPTEMBER, 1934.

CEMENT - The Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa reports that the Canadian production of cement in September amounted to 499,085 barrels as against 567,785 barrels in August and 424,710 barrels in September, 1933. During the nine months ending September 2,986,941 barrels of cement were produced in Canada or 25.6 per cent above the production in the corresponding months of 1933.

Exports of Portland cement from Canada were recorded at 6,837 barrels in September as compared with 9,279 barrels in the preceding month.

Cement importations into Canada in September rose to 1,179 barrels worth 3,359 from the preceding month's total of 917 barrels at 4,716. The September imports were made up of 930 barrels from Great Britain and 249 barrels from the United States.

CLAY PRODUCTS - Canadian producers sold clay and clay products worth \$229,497 in September as compared with \$245,178 in the preceding month and \$264,344 in September, 1933. Sales during the first three quarters of 1934 were valued at \$1,798,875; in the corresponding period of last year the value of sales was \$1,690,887 and in the first nine months of 1932 the total value was \$2,999,099.

Canada exported clay and clay products worth \$19,590 in September as against an export valuation of \$14,994 in the preceding month.

Imports of clay and clay products in Canada in September were appraised at \$422,159 and were obtained from the following countries: Great Britain, 48.2 per cent; the United States, 39.8 per cent; Japan, 7.5 per cent; Germany, 2.4 per cent, and Italy, Czechoslovakja, Austria, Palestine, Australia, China, France, Belgium, Hong Kong, Sweden, Netherlands and Denmark, the remainder. In August the value of importations of clay and clay products was \$545,830; Great Britain and the United States were the principal sources of the month's imports.

LIME - The production of lime in Canada during October was reported at 29,790 tons as compared with 26,965 tons in September and 35,648 tons in October, 1933. Production during the ten months ending October totalled 297,019 tons or 13.2 per cent above the tonnage produced during the period, January to October, 1933.

Lime exports from Canada in October rose to 1,205 tons from the preceding month's total of 878 tons. Imports of lime into Canada in October were negligible, amounting to only 1 ton as against 35 tons in the previous month.
