## CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS AND IINE PKODUCIIOIV - JANUARY, 1935.

CEMENT - Shipments of Portland cement by Canadian producers amounted to 53,479 barrels in January as compared with 82,498 barrels in December and 68,784 barrels in January, 1934, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa.

Exports of Portland cement from Canada in January declined to 616 barrels from the December total of 7,108 berrels and the January, 1934, total of 847 barrels.

Canada imported 239 barrels of cement worch $\$ 623$ during January as against 1,331 barrels at $\$ 4,005$ in December and 506 barrels at $\$ 2,298$ in January, 1934. The January, 1935, importations were obtainea from the United States.

Exports of clay and clay products from Canada declinod in value to $\$ 12,294$ from the Ducember total of $\$ 26,495$ and the January, 1934 , total of $\$ 21,615$.

Canada importod clay and ciay products to a viluc of $\mathrm{i}_{\mathrm{w}} 4 \mathrm{~s}^{2} 8,407$ as compared with $\$ 405,305$ in Decembur and 5358,648 in January, 1904. Thu United Status supplied 49.4 per cont of the January, 1935, importations; Great Britain, 38.1 per cent; Japan, 9.4 per cont, and Germay, Frence, Belgium, Italy, Palestino, China, the Nethorlands, Czochoslovakia, Fone Kong, Denmurk, Swodon, and Poland, the remainder.

LIME - The Canadian production of limo in February advanced to 29,018 tons from tho Januery total of 28,873 tons and the Fabruory, 1934, output of 27,388 tons. During Januexy and Fobruary, 1935, Canada produced 57,891 tons of lime as compared with 53,448 tons in the corresponding months of 1934.

Lime exportations from Canada wore rocorded at 616 tons in Fobruary; during the previous month 268 tons were exported.

Imports of limo into Cenada in Fubruary amounted to 29 tons worth $\$ 359$ as against 66 tons at $\$ 1,399$ imported in January.
