CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS AND LIME PRODUCTION - FEBRUARY, 1935.

CEMENT - Portland cement shipments by Canadian producers rose to 70,776 barrels in February from the January total of 53,479 barrels and the February, 1934, shipments of 66,571 barrels, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the first two months of the current year 124,255 barrels of Portland cement were shipped as compared with 135,355 barrels in the corresponding period of 1934.

Canada exported 1,099 barrels of Portland cement in February; during the preceding month 616 barrels were exported.

Imports of cement into Canada in February advanced to 1,636 barrels worth \$5,255 from the January total of 239 barrels at \$623. Receipts during February, 1935, consisted of 44.7 per cent from Great Britain, 36.0 per cent from the United States and 19.3 per cent from Japan.

CLAY PRODUCTS - Sales of clay products produced from domestic clays in Canada were valued at \$88,873 in February as compared with \$79,976 in the preceding month and \$96,428 in February, 1934.

The Canadian exports of clay and clay products in February were evaluated at \$14,898; in the previous month the export valuation was \$12,294.

Imports of clay and clay products into Canada in February were appraised at \$423,528 of which Great Britain supplied 45.4 per cent; the United States, 44.8 per cent; Japan, 6.6 per cent, and Germany, France, Czechoslovakia, Belgium, Palestine, China, Sweden, Hong Kong, Italy, Mexico and the British West Indies, the remainder. The January importations were valued at \$448,407 made up of 49.4 per cent from the United States, 39.1 per cent from Great Britain, 9.4 per cent from Japan and the remainder from Germany, France, Belgium, Italy, Palestine, China, the Netherlands, Czechoslovakia, Hong Kong, Denmark, Sweden and Poland.

LIME - Lime shipments from Canadian kilns advanced to 39,979 tons from the preceding month's total of 38,377 tons and the February, 1936, shipments of 28,133 tons. During the first two months of 1937, Canada shipped 78,356 tons of lime; this represented an increase of 34.3 per cent over the shipments a year ago.

A decline of 60.4 per cent was recorded in the exports of lime from Canada in February, as compared with the preceding month; the totals were 160 tons and 404 tons, respectively.

Canada imported 75 tons of lime appraised at \$728; in January 137 tons worth \$1,139 were imported.
