## CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS AND LIME PRODUCTION - MAY, 1935.

CEMENT - The Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa reports that shipments of Portland cement by Canadian producers amounted to 387,684 barrels, an increase of 58.8 per cent over the April total and 1.6 per cent over the May, 1934 shipments. During the five months ending May, 886,860 barrels were produced in Canada as compared with 834,528 barrels in the corresponding period of 1934.

Exports of Portland cement from Canada during May totalled 5,186 barrels worth \$4,547 as against 1,523 barrels at \$923 exported in April.

Canadian imports of cement in May consisted of 1,270 barrels at \$3,870 from Great Britain, 551 barrels at \$2,630 from the United States, 157 barrels at \$190 from Belgium and 32 barrels at \$120 from Italy. The April importations included 692 barrels worth \$4,029 from the United States and 329 barrels at \$371 from Great Britain.

CLAY PRODUCTS - Canadian producers reported sales of clay and clay products valued at \$259,689 in May; in the preceding month the value of sales was \$190,938 and in May, a year ago, the total was \$258,775. Sales during the five months ending May were evaluated at \$756,476 as compared with \$797,446 in the corresponding period of 1934.

Clay and clay products exported from Canada in May were worth \$33,698 or 105.4 per cent above the April total of \$16,403. British India was the chief importer of these products in May, absorbing 73 per cent of the total exports.

An advance of 33.8 per cent was recorded in the imports of clay and clay products into Canada in May; the month's imports were worth \$598,140 as against \$447,140 in April. The May imports were drawn from the following sources: Great Britain, 51.5 per cent; the United States, 34.2 per cent; Japan. 9.6 per cent; Germany, 3.0 per cent; and Belgium, Czechoslovakia, France, China, Italy, Sweden, Hong Kong, Bermuda, Hawaii and Spain, the remainder.

LIME - Lime production in Canada during June totalled 32,451 tons; in the previous month 34,214 tons were produced and in June, 1934, the output was 31,984 tons. Canadian producers reported a production of 192,321 tons of lime during the first half of 1935 as compared with 180,376 tons a year ago.

Canada exported 578 tons of lime during June; in May, 169 tons were exported. Exports during the six months ending June totalled 2,860 tons or 52.7 per cent below the tonnage shipped from Canada in the corresponding period of 1934.

Lime imports in June declined to 27 tons worth \$341 from the May total of 51 tons at \$678. Importations during the period January to June amounted to 247 tons appraised at \$4,051 as against 180 tons at \$2,853, a year ago.
