## MONTHY REPORT

CEIFNT, CLAY PRODUCTS AND LIME PRODICTION - OCTOBER, 1937.

CEMENT - TMe Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottama reports that the shipments of Portland cement by Canadian producers in October amounted to 770,730 barrels; in September, 937,749 barrels rere shipned while in October, 1936, shipments totalled 573,909 berrels. During the ten months ending October, $5,540,425$ barrels were shipped; this reprosented an increase of 35.5 per cent over the total for the corresponding period of 1930.

Portland cement exnorts from Canada were recorded at 2,956 barrels or 7.2 per cont below the September total of 5,186 barrels. Exports durinz the first ten months of 1037 aggregated 46,205 barrels against 51,355 barrels a year aģo.

Imports of cenent into Canada during October rose to 7,965 barrels appraised at 13,751 from the September importations of 5,090 barrels at $\mathbf{1 2 , 4 6 0}$. The October recelnts were obtained from the folloring countries - Belgium, 5,011 barrels; Great Britain, 1,848 barrels, and the United Sto.tes, 1,106 barrels.

CLAY PRODJCTS - Sales of clay and clay products during October were valued at 439,080 compared ritin 496,051 in the preceding montr and 371,131 in October, 1975. During the first ton montis of 1537 an increase of 20.3 per cent mas recorded in the sales of these products; the current year's total was "3,559, 322 while in the corresponding montis, a year $2 \xi 0$, the value of sales was $2,959,305$.

A decline of 57.3 per cent vas shom in the exports of clay and its moducts during October compured rith the previous month; the totals were 35,069 and "32,152, respectivelyr.

Imnorts of clay and its products into Canada Fiere appraised at 2910,316 in October or 27.4 neI cent above the value of the September imports. The October receipts :ere obtained principslly from the folloving sources - Great Britain, 50.6 per cent; the United States, 41.2 per cent; Jenan, 4.5 per cent, and Germeny, 1.9 per cent.

LIME - Lirae shiphaents from Canadian kilns in Tovember amounted to 46,575 tons or $2 . \overline{9}$ per cent above the tomage shipped a yoar ajo. In Octojer, 1337, shipments totalled 47,301 tons. During the first eleven months of 1037 an increase of 16.4 per cent was recorded in the ciuantity of lime shipped compared with the corresponding period of 1938 ; the totals wore 405,297 tons and 425,444 tons, rospectively.

The Canadian exports of lime in November advanced to 1,174 tons from the previous month's total of 354 tons. Exports to the end of November, 1937, aggregated 9,601 tons.

Imports of lino during November rose to 580 tons at 3,207 from the October importations of 553 tons at 3,214 . Recoipts during the period January to November totalled 4,365 tons worth 29,500 against 827 tons apmraised at M10,912, a year ago.
