MONTHLY REPORT

CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS and LIME - DECEMBER, 1938.

CEMENT - Portland cement shipments by Canadian producers in December were recorded at 174,848 barrels compared with 397,066 barrels in the preceding month and 187,466 barrels in December, 1937, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Shipments during the calendar year 1938 totalled 5,507,014 barrels; a year ago, 6,168,971 barrels were shipped while in 1936 the total was 4,508,718 barrels.

An increase of 50.9 per cent was shown in the exports of cement from Canada in December compared with the preceding month's exportations; the totals were - 19,431 barrels and 12,873 barrels, respectively. During 1938 Canada exported 89,419 barrels of cement; Trinidad received 34.4 per cent of this total and Colombia, 16.7 per cent.

Imports of cement into Canada declined to 755 barrels worth \$3,418 from the November total of 3,909 barrels at \$14,484. Receipts during the year aggregated 48,498 barrels appraised at \$105,326. Belgium supplied 71.4 per cent of the year's total, the United States, 16.5 per cent; Great Britain, 12.0 per cent, and Italy and Japan, the remainder.



CLAY PRODUCTS - Sales of clay and clay products (produced from domestic clays) in December were valued at \$223,242; the November sales were worth \$402,885 and the December, 1937, sales valuation was \$254,183. During 1938 the Canadian sales were valued at \$4,141,305 compared with \$4,516,859 in 1937 and \$3,471,027 in 1936.

Exports of clay and its products from Canada in December were worth \$58,260 thus making the total for the year \$546,005, or 8.5 per cent below the 1937 total.

Imports of clay and its products into Canada in December were appraised at \$457,010 compared with the November total of \$687,543. The value of the importations

LIME - Shipments of lime from Canadian kilns amounted to 35,309 tons in January compared with 37,042 tons in December and 32,633 tons in January, 1938.

Exports of lime during the month under review were negligible; in December, 683 tons were exported from Canada.

Receipts of lime in January declined to 284 tons worth \$1,915 from the preceding month's total of 394 tons at \$1,994.
