MONTILLY REPORT

CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS AND LIME PRODUCTION - FEBRUARY, 1938.

CEMENT - Shipments of Portland cement by Canadian producers in February rose to 143,446 barrels from the preceding month's total of 132,263 barrels and the February, 1937, total of 101,171 barrels, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the first two months of 1938 shipments amounted to 275,709 barrels or 38.9 per cent above the quantity shipped in the corresponding period of 1937.

Exports of Portland cement in February were recorded at 1,090 barrels compared with 853 barrels in January and 44 barrels in February, 1937.

The Canadian imports of Portland cement advanced to 803 barrels valued at 13.559 from the preceding month's total of 588 barrels at 12,767. The United States supplied 52.5 per cent of the February imports, Great Britain, 31.3 per cent, and Belgium, 16.2 per cent.

CLAY PRODUCTS - Canadian producers reported sales of clay and clay products (produced from domestic clays) valued at \$147,515 compared with the previous month's total of \$145,451 and the February, 1937, value of \$127,313. Sales during the two months ending February, 1938, rose 11.4 per cent in value to \$292,966 from the total for the corresponding period of 1937.

Canada exported clay and its products in February to a value of \$24,120 compared with the January valuation of \$38,603.

An advance of 6.5 per cent was recorded in the imports of clay and its products into Canada; the February imports were worth \$631,192 and the January, \$592,525. The February receipts were obtained from the following sources: the United States, 49.8 per cent; Great Britain, 45.3 per cent; Japan, 2.6 per cent; Germany, 1.1 per cent; and Czechoslovakia, France, Palestine, Denmark, Italy, Belgium, China, Hong Kong, Poland, Hungary, Guatemala and India, the remainder.

LIME - Canadian producers reported shipments of lime in March amounting to 38,755 tons compared with 32,424 tons shipped in the preceding month and 46,583 tons in March, 1937, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Eureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Shipments during the first three months of 1938 totalled 103,812 tons; a year ago, 124,939 tons were shipped while in the corresponding period of 1936 shipments amounted to 96,217 tons.

Exports of lime rose to 1,301 tons from the February total of 291 tons. During the first quarter of the current year 2,162 tons were exported.

Receipts of lime in March declined 5.5 per cent to 648 tons from the February imports of 686 tons. The March importations were obtained from the United States.
