

QSIFT - Shipments of Portland cement by Canadian producers amounted to $701,3 \%$ varrels in September; during the preceding month, 71i, 753 barrels were shipped while in September, 1937, shipments totalled 342,196 barrels, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the first nine months of the current year, $4,2 \kappa 4,965$ barrels were shipped compared with $4,792,317$ barrels, a year ago.
apports of Portland cement in September were recorded at 7,042 barrels; during musut, 9,661 barreis were exposted. Trinidad received 38.8 per cent of the Sertwiso exports and Newfoundlend, 24.4 per cent.

An increase of 52.4 per cent was recorded in the imnorts of cement during September compared with the importations in the previous month; the totals were 5,831 barrels valued at $\$ 14,003$, and 3,859 barrels at 4,259 , respectively. The September receipts were obtained from the following countries: Bolgium, 4,071 barrels at 4,833 ; the United States, 932 barrel.s at $\$ 4,719$, and Great Britain, 878 barrels 2 54,451 。

CLAY PRODUCTS - The value of the sales of clay products (produced from domestic clays) declined to 4285,824 in September from the previous month's total of $\$ 504,871$ and the September, 1937, total of $\$ 528,676$. Sales during the first nine months of 1938 were valued at $\$ 3,023,391$ or 8.2 per cent below the value for the corresponding period of 1937.

Exports of clay and its products were worth $\$ 28,207$ in September; the August total was \$24,150. During the year to date Canada exported these commodities to a value of $\$ 388,825$ or 16.5 per cent below the total for the corresponding period of 1937.
