CEMDNT - Canadian producers rsported shinaenta of Portiand cement araounting to 115,533 barrals in Jenuary; during the nocedine rannit, 174,313 barrels rere shinnd While in January, 1938 , shipments tot-lled $1.32,0 \%$ berrels, according to e. stetenent just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Stntistics r.t Ottaris.

Exports of cement from Canada wore recorded at $\therefore, 377$ harrels in Jani:iry compared with 19,431 barrels in December. Peru received $31 . \hat{\alpha}$ per cent of the Jonuery exports and the British lest Indies and the United States, the romainder.

Canada imported 343 berrels of cement yorth 1, 060 in Jenuery; in December; 755 barrels at 53,418 mere imported. The Jenuary receirts consisted of 2.24 brrels valued at ${ }^{2} 1,323$ from the United States and 124 berrels et " 637 from Creat Britoin.

LIME - Shipments of lime by Canadian producers in February totalled 33,455 tons; in January, 35,808 tons were shipped while in February, a year ago; 32,424 tons were shipped. During the first two months of 1939 shipments amounted to 69,264 tons or 6.5 per cent above the tonnage shipped a year ago.

Exports of lime for building purposes were recorded at 265 tons in Fobruary and exportations of other lime amounted to 1,010 tons.

Imports of lime into Canada rose to 560 tons worth $\$ 2,402$ imom he Jenuary total of 284 tons at $\$ 1,915$.
