## MONTHLY REPORT

## THE WAY CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS and LIME - NOVEMBER,

CEMENT - Portland cement shipments from Canadian plants in November were recorded at 421,569 barrels compared with 681,218 barrels in the preceding month and 397,938 barrels in November, 1938, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Shipments during the first eleven months of 1939 totalled 5,528,322 barrels; this represented a 3.5 per cent increase over the quantity shipped a year ago.

Exports of Portland cement from Canada in November rose to 41,846 barrels from the October total of 20,813 barrels. Exportations in 1939 to the end of November aggregated 136,643 barrels.

Canada imported 733 barrels of cement worth \$2,335 in November; during the previous month, 743 barrels at \$4,234 were imported.

CLAY PRODUCTS - Canadian producers reported sales of clay products (made from domestic clays) valued at \$468,040 in November; the October sales were worth \$529,843 while the November, 1938 sales were valued at \$437,059.

Customs' records show that clay and its products to the value of \$28,091 were exported in November compared with the October total of \$26,991.

Receipts of clay and its products in November were appraised at \$962,231; the October imports were valued at \$716,356. Importations during the period January to November, 1939 were worth \$7,127,114.

LIME - The Canadian production of lime in December amounted to 54,780 tons; in November, 59,637 tons were produced while in December, 1938 the output was 38,044 tons. Production during the calendar year 1939 aggregated 530,904 tons as against 486,922 tons a year ago.

Building lime exports in December declined to 119 tons from the preceding month's total of 495 tons. Other lime exportations were 93.3 per cent lower at 57 tons.

Imports of lime into Canada in December totalled 414 tons worth \$2,626 against 471 tons at \$2,516 imported in November. Importations during the twelve months aggregated 6,058 tons valued at \$33,342 compared with 6,652 tons at \$36,248 in 1938.
