

CEMENT - Canadian producers reported shipments of Portland cement in April amounting to 273,969 barrels, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In March, 208,779 barrels were shipped while in April, 1938, shipments amounted to 364,086 barrels. Durine the first four months of the current year, 716,886 berrels were shipped; in the corrosponding period of 1938 shioments totalled 873,104 barrels.

Canada exported 24 barrels of Portland cement during April compared with 165 barrels in the preceding month. Exports during the four months ending April aggregated 3,213 barrels or 65.7 per cent below the quantity exported a yeur ago.

Imports of cement into Canada in April duclineâ to 527 barrels worth $\$ 1,995$ from the March total of 932 barrels at $\$ 3,978$. The April importations consisted of 256 barrels valuod at $\$ 1,345$ from Grat Britain, $18 \varepsilon$ barruls at $\$ 296$ from Bulgium, 63 barrals at $\$ 225$ from Franco, and 20 varrels at $\$ 139$ from the United States.

CLAY PRODUCTS - Salos of clay products (produced irom Canadien clays) wore valued at $\$ 235,520$ in hpril; the precoding nonth's salus whe worth $\$ 190,256$ while the value of thu April, 1939, sulus was highor at $\$ 264,689$. During the first four months of the currunt yoar the Canadian salas vore valued at $\$ 709,468$ or 6.1 per cont bolow the total for the correspondine period of 1938.

A 52.4 per cent incrcasu wes rocorded in the velue of the exports of clay and its products from Canade in April; the mont!'s total was $\$ 40,982$ comperod with $\$ 26,883$ in March.

Clay and its products to a valuo of $\$ 527,795$ wcre imported into Canada in April; during the procoding month tho import valuation wes $\$ 651,798$. The United States suppliod 52.7 per cont of tho April imports and Great Britain, 43.0 per cent.

IINE - An increase of 15 per cent was recorded in the tonnage of lime sold or used by Canadian producers in May compared with the preceding month; the totals were 44,247 tons and 38,491 tons, respectively. In May, a year ago, 41,756 tons were shipped. During the f1ret five months of the current year shipments from Canadian kilns aggregated 189,939 tons or 2.8 per cent above the quantity shipped in the corresponding months of 1938.

Canade exported 716 tons of building lime and 772 tons of other lime in May; in the previous month, 1 ton of the former and 30 tons of the latter were exported.

Receipts of lime from the United States amounted to 510 tons appraised at $\$ 2,888$ compered with 544 tons at $\$ 2,554$ in April.
