MONTHLY REPORT

CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS and LIME - MAY, 1989

CEMENT - The Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa reports that shipments of Portland cement by Canadian producers amounted to 550,890 barrels in May compared with 273,969 barrels in April and 545,310 barrels in May, 1938. During the five months ending May, 1,267,776 barrels were shipped; this represented a decrease of 10.6 per cent from the quantity shipped a year ago.

Exports of Portland cement from Canada in May totalled 12,247 barrels; in the preceding month 24 barrels were exported. The total quantity exported this year, to the end of May, was 15,460 barrels.

Canada imported 2.557 barrels of cement worth \$9,022 in May; the April imports were lower at 527 barrels with a valuation of \$1,995. The United States supplied 42.5 per cent of the total imports in May; Belgium, 39.0 per cent, and Great Britain, 18.5 per cent.

CLAY PRODUCTS - Canadian producers reported that the sales of clay products (produced from domestic clays) were valued at \$395,422 in May or 68.3 per cent above the April total and 4.4 per cent above the May, 1938, sales. During the first five months of 1939 sales were valued at \$1,105,890 compared with \$1,135,561 a year ago.

Exports of clay and its products from Canada in May were worth \$63,787; the April exports were valued at \$40,982.

Imports of clay and its products into Canada in May were appraised at \$790,526 as against \$527.795 in April. Sixty per cent of the May importations were obtained from Great Britain and 34 per cent from the United States.

LIME - Canadian producers sold or used 44,441 tons of lime during June; in the previous month the total was 43,549 tons while in June, a year ago, 41,184 tons were sold or used. During the first six months of the current year, 233,003 tons were shipped from Canadian kilns compared with 231,343 tons a year ago.

Exports of building lime in June declined to 496 tons worth \$4,100 from the May total of 716 tons at \$5,716. During the period January to June, 2,130 tons of building lime were exported from Canada. Exportations of other lime in June amounted to 229 tons compared with 772 tons in May.

Canada imported 624 tons of lime worth \$3,467 in June; during May, 510 tons valued at \$2,889 were imported.
