## MONTHLY REPORT

CEMENT, CLAY PRODUCTS and LIME - JUNE, 1939.

CEMENT - Portland cement shipments by Canadian producers rose to 727,842 barrels from the preceding month's total of 550,890 barrels, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In June, a year ago, 750,691 barrels were shipped. During the first six months of the current year shipments totalled 1,995,618 barrels or 8.1 per cent below the total for the corresponding months of 1938.

Canada exported 7,505 barrels of Portland cement in June compared with 12,247 barrels in the preceding month. Exports to the end of June, this year, aggregated 22,965 barrels.

Imports of cement into Canada in June amounted to 2,352 barrels valued at \$9,149, making the total for the first six months 7,069 barrels valued at \$26,785.



CLAY PRODUCTS - Sales of clay products (produced from domestic clays) in June were valued at \$483,535; the May sales were worth \$396,422 while the June, 1938, sales were valued at \$471,313. During the first six months of 1939 the value of sales of these commodities was \$1,589,425 or 7.1 per cent below the valuation for the corresponding period of 1938.

Clay and its products exported from Canada in June were appraised at \$26,041 as against the May total of \$63,737.

Importations of clay and its products into Canada were valued at \$655,528 in Jume or 17.1 per cent below the May valuation. Receipts during the first half of the current year were worth \$6,551,378.

LIME - A five per cent increase was shown in the tonnage of lime sold or used by Canadian producers in July compared with the corresponding month of 1938; the totals were 42,249 tons and 40,247 tons, respectively. During the seven months ending July shipments totalled 275,252 tons; a year ago, 271,590 tons were shipped.

Customs' records show that 517 tons of building lime were exported from Canada in July as against 496 tons in the previous month. Exports of other lime rose to 289 tons from the June total of 229 tons.

Imports of lime in July amounted to 463 tons with a valuation of \$2396; in June, 624 tons worth \$3467 were imported.
