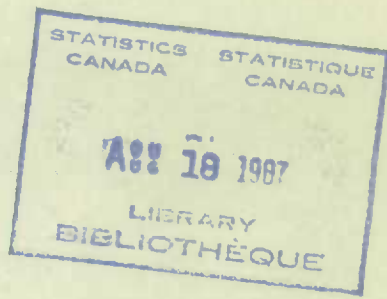

Shipments to customers by Canadian manufacturers of Portland cement totalled 929,283 barrels in November, 1946, compared with 1,189,291 barrels in October. In 1945, the November shipments amounted to 693,892 barrels as against 1,103,372 barrels in the previous month. Actual production for November, 1946, was 973,812 barrels.
