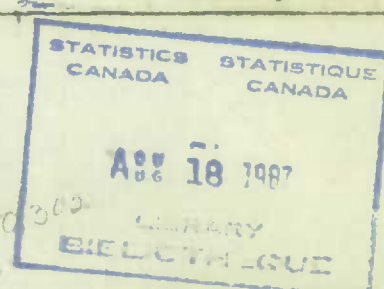

Shipments to customers by Canadian manufacturers of Portland Cement totalled 1,350,395 barrels in July, 1946, compared with 1,159,702 barrels in June. In 1945, the July shipments amounted to 1,159,702 barrels as against 1,040,927 in the previous month. Actual production for July, 1946, was 1,062,671 barrels.
