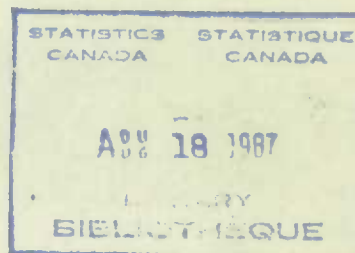

September, 1946



Shipments to customers by Canadian manufacturers of Portland cement totalled 1,141,478 barrels in September, 1946, compared with 1,228,776 barrels in August. In 1945, the September shipments amounted to 1,007,503 barrels as against 1,047,986 barrels in the previous month. Actual production for September, 1946, was 989,714 barrels.
