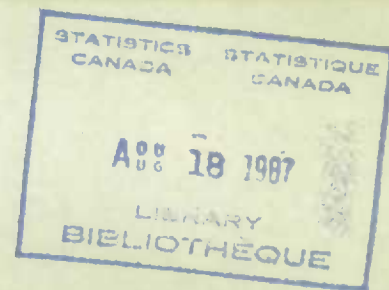

Shipments to customers by Canadian manufacturers of Portland cement totalled 1,290,762 barrels in May, 1947 compared with 1,060,400 barrels in April. In 1946, the May shipments amounted to 1,532,854 barrels as against 1,002,065 barrels in the previous month. Actual production for May, 1947 was 950,086 barrels.

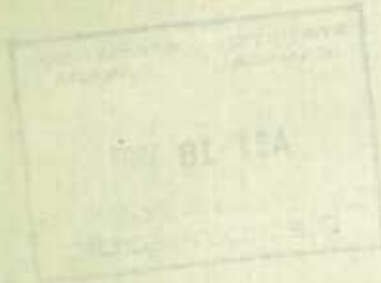
