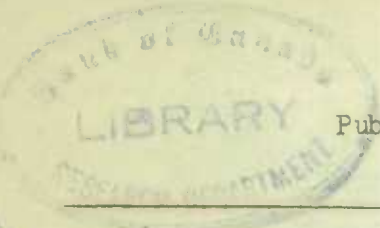

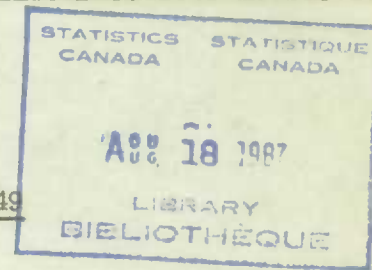

CEMENT AND CEMENT PRODUCTS - APRIL, 1949



Shipments to customers by Canadian manufacturers of Portland cement totalled 1,535,469 barrels in April, 1949 compared with 1,402,176 barrels in March. In 1948 the April shipments amounted to 1,266,731 barrels as against 1,071,977 barrels in the previous month. Actual production for April, 1949 was 1,275,150 barrels compared with 1,038,457 barrels in the corresponding month of 1948.

The April output of concrete building materials included the following items: brick, 2,169,154 pieces; hollow blocks, 2,952,999 pieces; cinder blocks, 884,808 pieces; chimney blocks, 15,878 pieces; and pipe, 8,068 tons. These figures represent production by 98 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total Canadian output of concrete products.
