CEVENT AND CEMENT PRODUCTS

JANUARY - 1950

Shipments to customers by Canadian manufacturers of Portland cement totalled 652,769 barrels in January, 1950 compared with 763,338 barrels in December, 1949. In 1949, the January shipments amounted to 621,044 barrels as against 741,662 barrels in the previous month. Actual production for January, 1950 was 1,252,505 barrels compared with 1,121,659 barrels in the corresponding month of 1949.

The January output of concrete building materials included the following items: brick, 1,194,729 pieces; hollow blocks, 2,369,435 pieces; cinder blocks, 754,555 pieces; chimney blocks, 33,072 pieces; and pipe, 6,762 tons. The figures represent production by 107 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total Canadian output of concrete products.


