



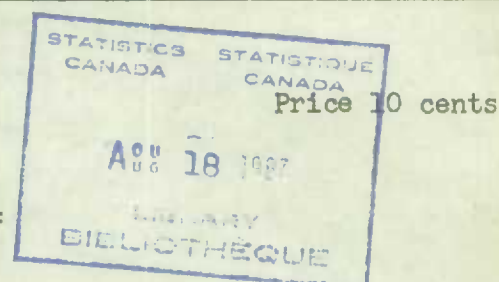

CEMENT AND CEMENT PRODUCTS

DECEMBER - 1950



Shipments to customers by Canadian manufacturers of Portland cement totalled 789,102 barrels in December 1950 compared with 1,433,793 barrels in the previous month. In 1949, the December shipments amounted to 763,338 barrels as against 1,382,515 barrels in the previous month. Actual production for December 1950 was 1,352,135 barrels compared with 1,308,392 barrels in the corresponding month of 1949.

The December output of concrete building materials included the following items: brick, 2,974,566 pieces; hollow blocks, 2,030,709 pieces; cinder blocks, 580,922 pieces; chimney blocks, 41,153 pieces; and pipe, 8,988 tons. These figures represent production by 105 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total Canadian output of concrete products.
