Shipments to customers by Canadian manufacturers of Portland cement totalled 1,232,931 barrels in March 1950 compared with 790,357 barrels in the previous month. In 1949, the March shipments amounted to 1,402,176 barrels as against 908,307 barrels in the previous month. Actual production for March, 1950 was 1,302,820 barrels compared with 1,339,704 barrels in the corresponding month of 1949.

The March cutput of concrete building materials included the following items: brick, 1,610,035 pieces; hollow blocks, 2,321,604 pieces; cinder blocks, 713,050 pieces; chimney blocks, 19,151 pieces; and pipe, 9,957 tons. These figures represent production by 113 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent. of the total Canadian output of concrete products.


