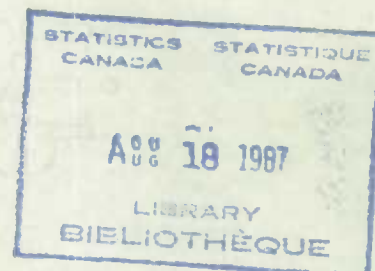

SEPTEMBER - 1950



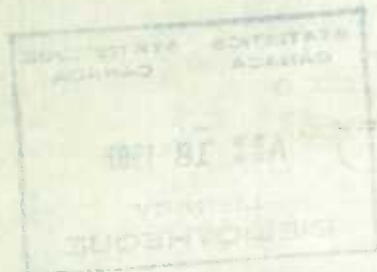
Shipments to customers by Canadian manufacturers of Portland cement totalled 1,614,467 barrels in September, 1950 compared with 1,613,177 barrels in the previous month. In 1949, the September shipments amounted to 1,558,989 barrels as against 1,652,752 barrels in the previous month. Actual production for September, 1950 was 1,444,646 barrels compared with 1,419,584 barrels in the corresponding month of 1949.

The September output of concrete building materials included the following items: brick, 5,391,936 pieces; hollow blocks, 4,995,127 pieces; cinder blocks, 1,256,195 pieces; chimney blocks, 76,903 pieces; and pipe, 11,416 tons. These figures represent production by 114 of the principal manufacturers which normally account for 85 per cent of the total Canadian output of concrete products.
