Actual production for August, 1951 was $1,512,626$ barrels, compared With $1,494,155$ barrels in the corresponding month of 1950.

The August output of concrete building materials included the following items: Brick, 2,877,298 pieces; gravel blocks, 5,209,798 pieces; cinder blocks, 957,946 pieces; other aggregates, 244,147 pieces; chimney blocks, 54,461 pieces; and pipe, 27,353 tons. These figures represent production by 122 of the principal manufacturers, which normally account for 85 per cent of the total Canadian output of concrete products.
