CEMENT AND CBMENTT PRODUCTS

JANUARY - 1952


Shipments to customers by Canadian manufacturers of Portland cement totalled 850,556 barrels in January, 1952 compared with 776,467 barrels in December, 195.1. In 1951 the January shipments amounted to 886,979 barrels, as against 789,102 barrels in December, 1950. Actual production for January, 1952 was 1,353,215 barrels, compared with 1,261,554 barrels in the corresponding month of 1951.

[^0]The January output of concrete building materials included the following items: brick, 1,258,870 pieces; gravel blocks, $2,219,831$ pieces; cinder blocks, 324,108 pleces; other aggregates, 180,612 pieces; chimney blocks, 30,681 pieces; pipe, 14,435 tons and concrete, ready-mixed, 25,445 cubic yards. These figures represent production by 127 of the principal manufacturers, which normally account for 85 per cent of the total Canadian output of concrete products.
