The July output of concrete building meterials included the following itams: brick, $4,338,907$ pieces; grevel blocks, 6,184,352 pleces; cinder blocks, 10108,470 pieces; other aggregates, 409,818 pleces; chimney blocks, 120,226 pleces; p1pe, 19, 172 tons, and concrete, ready-mixed, 176,066 cubic yards. These figurgs represent production by 141 of the principal manufacturers, which normally account for 85 per cent of the total Canadian output of concrete products.
