Shipments to customers by Canadian manufacturers of Portland cement totalled 379,284 tons in April, 1957, compared with 315,418 tons in the previous month. In 1956 the April shipments amounted to 423,549 tons. Actual production for April, 1957, was 413,928 tons compared with 435,126 tons in the corresponding month of 1956.
