## PRODICTS MADE FRCH CIUADIAN CLAYS

Sales by concerns in Canada which made products from domestic clays totalled $\$ 1,638,046$ during January, 1954, compared with $\$ 2,280,818$ in the previous month. The corresponding total for January, 1953, was $\leqslant 1,745,152$.
