## PRODUCTS MADL FFOR LANADIAN CLLAYS

Sales by concerns in Canada which made products from domestic clays totelled $\$ 3,227,899$ during June, 1954, compred with $\$ 2,658,478$ In the previous month. The corresponding totel for June, 1953, was $\$ 2,654,894$.
