## PRODUCTS MADE FROM CANADIAN CLAYS

OCTOBER - 1951

Sales by concerns in Canada which made products from domestic clays totalled $\mathbf{\$ 2 , 2 5 4 , 3 3 9}$ during October, 1951, compared with $\$ 1,966,321$ in the previous month. The corresponding total for October, 1950 was \$2,149,582.
