## THE CEMENT PRODUCTS INDUSTRY IN CANADA 1927.

ocment products made in Canada reached a new high level of values during 1927 at \$2,663,065, according to a statement issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. This output represented an increase of 5 per cent over the \$2,544,242 in 1926 which in turn was 26 per cent over the production value of \$2,020,239 reported for 1925.

A total of 151 plants were engaged in this line of manufacture in 1927; 109 were located in Ontario, 31 in Quebec, 5 in British Columbia, 2 in Nova Scotia, 2 in Saskatchewan, and 1 each in New Brunswick and Alberta. These concerns represented a capital investment of \$2,671,273; employed an average of 872 people monthly, paid out \$936,053 in salaries and wages, and by manufacturing processes added \$1,750,379 to the value of purchased materials which cost \$912,686 delivered at the works.
