For statistical purposes the industry titled Concrete Products Manufacturers in the revised Standard Industrial Classification covers the operations of establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing concrete products such as building blocks, brick, sewer pipe, tanks, poles and septic tanks, etc. Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing sand-lime bricks and blocks are also included. Establishments primarily engaged in mixing and delivering ready-mix concrete are classified to the Ready-Mix Concrete Manufacturers industry (S.I.C. 348). Figures on cement work undertaken by firms classified for statistical purposes in the area of construction are not included. The latter type of work is covered in the annual survey of construction.

Value of shipments and other revenues (manufacturing and non-manufacturing) of the Concrete Products Manufacturers industry amounted to \$206.1 millions in 1967 compared with \$209.7 millions in 1966, a decrease of \$3.6 millions, or about 1.7 per cent.

The cost of materials and supplies, fuel and electricity, etc. (inputs) used in the production of goods of own manufacture decreased by \$3.1 millions. Cost of inputs in 1967 represented 39.8 per cent of the value of gross manufacturing output compared to 40.3 per cent in 1966.

This industry's shipments of concrete and sand-lime products represented 97 per cent of its manufacturing revenue. Secondary products shipped in 1967 included sand and stone, insulating materials, bathroom accessories, etc.

It should be noted that Table 8 covers the shipments of the establishments classified to this industry, whereas Table 9 presents the total value of shipments of specific commodities of Canadian manufacture, and includes shipments of those commodities reported by establishments classified to other industries.

Tables on principal statistics classified by manufacturing value added, by total value added, and by type of organization, published in the 1966 report as Tables 3, 4 and 6, respectively, have been omitted from this report because of their limited interest. They are available, however, from the Manufacturing and Primary Industries Division. In the case of an extensive request involving a large number of industries, it may be necessary to levy a charge.
3. Users interested in obtaining the value of production (manufacturing activity) can do so by adding cost of materials and supplies used (manufacturing activity), cost of fuel and electricity, and value added (manufacturing activity). The resulting statistic is equivalent in concept to "gross output" shown in Table 7 of the 1966 report.

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
