## THE GLASS INDUSTRY, IN CANADA, 1926.

According to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa, the production of pressed and blown glass in Canada during 1926 amounted in value to \$8,390,035 and the output of plate, cut and ornamental glass during the same year reached a value of \$3,280,234, making a total for the induciar of \$11,670,269 as compared with the corresponding figure of \$10,117,604 Low 1925. Capital employed in the industry in 1926 totalled \$11,432,823, a decline of more than a million dollars from the total for 1925; the number of employees was 3,033 as against 2,778 in the previous year and payments in salaries and wages totalled \$3,443,644 as compared with \$3,291,912 in 1925.

In the pressed and blown glass industry there were 7 plants in operation during 1926 located as follows: 4 in Ontario, 2 in Quebec and 1 in Alberta. Production was valued at \$8,390,035 as compared with \$7,444,246 in 1925.

In the plate, cut and ornamental glass industry which included all concerns engaged in the bevelling and working of glass to produce such commodities as bevelled plates, cut glass, memorial windows, leaded glass, mirrors, art glass, showcases, etc., the number of plants in operation was <sup>11</sup>5 distributed as follows: 7 in Quebec; 28 in Ontario; 5 in British Columbia; 3 in Manitoba and 1 in each of New Brunswick and Alberta. Production from plants in this line of work was valued at \$3,280,23<sup>4</sup> in 1926 as compared with \$2,673,358 in 1925.

Imports of glass and glassware into Canada during the calendar year 1926 reached a total value of \$8,515,284 as compared with \$7,155,760 in the previous year. Among the main articles imported during 1926 were 41.9 million square feet of common window glass worth \$1,264,318, as against 35.6 million square feet at \$1,248,712 in 1925; glass carboys, dem johns, etc., valued at \$1,344,790 as compared with \$1,108,285 in 1925; plate glass worth \$2,428,076, as against a value of \$1,829,007 placed on the imports in the previous year; cut glass valued at \$836,581 as compared with a corresponding value of \$688,881 in 1925; lamp chimneys and shades worth \$391,360 as against \$330,182 in 1925; unfinished lenses worth \$88,432 as against \$149,825 in 1925; milk bottles at \$33,302 as compared with a figure of \$44,576 in the preceding year, and considerable quantities of stained, ornamental and silvered glass and other glass products. Exports of Canadian-made glass and glassware from Canada reached a total value of \$214,896 during 1926 and \$307,817 in 1925, while re-exports of foreign-made goods of this class amounted in value to \$22,254 during 1926 and \$22,901 during the previous year.
