Shipments of gypsum from Canadian deposits during 1928 totalled 1,246,368 tons valued at \$3,743,648 and set a new high record for the industry, according to final revised statistics just issued by the mining, metallurgical and chemical branch of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Production (shipments) in 1927 amounted to 1,063,117 tons worth \$3,251,015. Gypsum quarried in 1928 totalled 1,311,642 tons of which quantity 226,997 tons or 17.3 per cent was calcined in Canada.

Quarries in Hants, Inverness and Victoria counties, Nova Scotia; Albert and Victoria counties, New Brunswick; near Paris, Ontario; Gypsumville, Manitoba; and at Falkland and Mayook, British Columbia, were worked during 1928.

Crude gypsum exported from Canadian quarries in 1928 amounted to 824,536 tons; this tonnage was shipped to the United States. Ground gypsum and prepared wall plaster exported during the year totalled 8,232 tons. The United States, New Zealand, Australia and Newfoundland were the principal importers of these materials from Canada.

Capital employed by the 16 firms operating in this industry in 1928 was reported at \$8,035,319. Employment was furnished 75 salaried employees and 1,084 wage-earners; their total earnings were \$1,171,814. The cost of fuel used during the year was \$242,360 which sum included \$65,181 paid for 5,060,964 k.w.h. of electric power. Primary power consisted of 187 units rated at 8,302 h.p.


