## THE KISCHLLANEOUS NON-METALIIC MINERAL PHOLUCTS INDUSTRY IN CANALA, 1928.

Production from a group of 17 plants in Canada making miscellaneous non-metallic mineral products was worth $\$ 4,799,640$ in 1928 , states a bulletin just published by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottama. In the group were included 5 plants ialcing. gypsum products, 3 factorics making carbon electrodes and artificial graphito; 2 mica trimming shops, 1 concorn milling cloctrical slate, and 6 other plants whose main products were foundry facings and supplics. Of the 17 factorics, 10 .wore locatod in Ontario, 5 in Queboc and I in oach of Manitoba and British Columbia.

Capital employed in this industry in 1928 totalled $\$ 8,331,500$; salaried employees numbering 126 were paid $\$ 260,818$ and the 869 wage-earners were paid $\$ 856,955$; fuel and electricity used by the reporting plants cost $\$ 315,887$ at the works; materials used cost $\$ 1,790,404$ and the value added by manufacturing was $\$ 3,009,236$.

In previous years, the concerns making ab rasive products were also included in this group but, for 1928 , a separate bulletin has been ussed on the abrasive industry. Data pertaining to the mamufacture of abrasives, therefore, are not included in the statistics presentod in this statement.
