

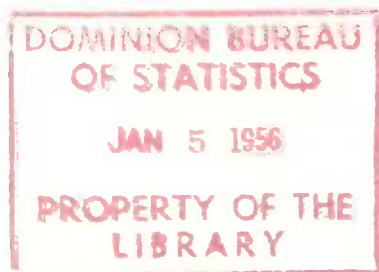

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REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

JULY - 1955

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during July, 1955, totalled 17,873,448 barrels compared with 14,581,086 barrels in July, 1954. The total for the month under review included 6,648,247 barrels of motor gasoline, 108,880 barrels of aviation gasoline, 3,094,666 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 1,883,653 barrels of diesel fuel, 2,067,202 barrels of furnace oil, 96,439 barrels of other light fuel oil, 966,544 barrels of kerosene and stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 45,208 barrels of tractor fuel, 150,760 barrels of aviation turbine fuel, 2,811,849 barrels of naphtha specialties, and other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 17,671,389 barrels of crude oil during July, 1955, compared with 14,008,461 barrels in July, 1954. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 18,580,887 barrels, including 8,444,009 barrels of imported oil and 10,136,878 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 19,650,323 barrels. This latter figure includes stocks held at the field, in pipeline systems and in refineries. Comparable figures on this basis are not available for 1954.

Net sales of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from production, imports, exports, changes in inventories, etc., were as follows in July, 1955, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: Naphtha specialties, 98,449; aviation gasoline, 398,879; motor gasoline, 7,450,053; tractor fuel, 25,491; aviation turbine fuel, 204,032; kerosene, 62,254; stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 202,311; diesel fuel, 1,377,967; furnace oil, 1,041,058; other light fuel oil, 62,205; and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 3,475,077.

NOTE: It is the practice of the External Trade Section to close off their records for a particular month with entries received at Ottawa on the last working day; accordingly, there may be some carry over into the next month. That is to say, imports during the last few days of a month at customs' ports such as Halifax, Vancouver, Montreal, etc., do not reach Ottawa in time for inclusion in that month's figures but are carried over into the totals for the following month. Figures shown in Table 3 have been adjusted by examining the individual customs' invoices and by pulling back any such carry over; Table 3, therefore, shows totals for the full month. For this reason the figures differ slightly from the figures shown in the above table.

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
