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## REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

SEPTEMBER - 1956

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during September, 1956, totalled 21,681,330 barrels compared with 17,231,493 barrels in September, 1955. The total for the month under review included 7,492,329 barrels of motor gasoline, 70,572 barrels of aviation gasoline, 4,369,498 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 1,733,828 barrels of diesel fuel, 3,449,286 barrels of light fuel oil, 1,235,945 barrels of kerosene and stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 75,929 barrels of tractor fuel, 487,568 barrels of aviation turbine fuel, 2,766,375 barrels of naphtha specialties, and other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 21,228,185 barrels of crude oil during September, 1956, compared with 16,865,966 barrels in September, 1955. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 20,907,901 barrels, including 10,013,544 barrels of imported oil and 10,894,357 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 21,836,294 barrels compared with 19,144,202 barrels on the corresponding date of last year. These figures include stocks held at the field, in pipeline systems and in refineries.

Net sales of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from production, imports, exports, changes in inventories, etc., were as follows in September, 1956, comparable figures for corresponding month of 1955 in brackets, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: Naphtha specialties, 100,992 (107,434); aviation gasoline, 376,621 (337,020); motor gasoline, 7,819,543 (7,717,958); tractor fuel, 10,992 (17,726); aviation turbine fuel, 252,281 (233,283); kerosene and stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 1,240,360 (844,302); diesel fuel, 1,887,382 (1,500,906); light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 2,145,095 (2,076,062) and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 3,949,086 (4,028,452).

- NOTE:** 1. It is the practice of the External Trade Section to close off their records for a particular month with entries received at Ottawa on the last working day; accordingly, there may be some carry-over into the next month. That is to say, imports during the last few days of a month at customs' ports such as Halifax, Vancouver, Montreal, etc., do not reach Ottawa in time for inclusion in the month's figures but are carried over into the totals for the following month. Figures shown in Table 3 have been adjusted by examining the individual customs' invoices and by pulling back any such carry-over; Table 3, therefore, shows totals for the full month. For this reason the figures differ slightly from the figures shown in the above table.
2. The above procedure applied to the tabulations up to and including April, 1956; however, due to the lateness of the availability of the import data, this Procedure has been discontinued starting with the current month and the import figures shown in Table 3 are unadjusted totals based on Table 4.
3. The External Trade Section makes no distinction in some cases between imports of finished lube oils and greases and certain kinds of blending stocks. This has resulted in some duplication in the Net Sales figures for lube oils and greases as the amount of blending stock in some cases has been also reported by companies as imports under "Blending stocks used". In order to allow for this duplication it has been necessary to reduce imports shown in Table 3 for lube oils and greases. The latter situation becomes effective with the present report and accounts for the difference shown for lube oils and greases under Imports in Tables 3 and 4.



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
