

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#### REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

#### January, 1958

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during January, 1958 totalled 20,921,150 barrels compared with 20,810,986 barrels in January, 1957. The total for the month under review included 7,640,545 barrels of motor gasoline, 32,796 barrels of aviation gasoline, 3,869,309 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 1,497,907 barrels of diesel fuel, 3,653,120 barrels of light fuel oil, 1,509,122 barrels of kerosene, stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil) and tractor fuel, 328,292 barrels of aviation turbine fuel, 2,390,059 barrels of naphtha specialties, and other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 20,739,502 barrels of crude oil during January, 1958, compared with 20,444,845 barrels in January, 1957. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 20,554,050 barrels, including 8,221,773 barrels of imported oil and 12,332,277 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 21,769,303 barrels compared with 22,942,148 barrels on the corresponding date of last year. These figures include stocks held at the field, in pipeline systems and in refineries.

Net sales of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from production, imports, exports, changes in inventories, etc., were as follows in January, 1958, comparable figures for corresponding month of 1957 in brackets, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons; Naphtha specialties, 99,779, (93,265), aviation gasoline 217,857 (235,316); motor gasoline, 5,938,297 (5,907,866); aviation turbine fuel, 289,495 (236,279); tractor fuel, kerosene and stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 2,073,830 (2,579,374); diesel fuel, 1,336,108 (1,354,971); light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 8,015,070 (8,871,999), and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 3,216,768 (4,561,939).

#### Explanatory Notes

Effective, January, 1958 the reports in this series will reflect a major change in concept involving the treatment of import data. It is hoped that the introduction of this new concept will in time result in an improvement in timeliness amounting to perhaps six to eight weeks. This new concept as well as other changes are reviewed in the following:

1. In normal practice it is possible for respondents to file reports to this survey within and usually not later than about six weeks; however, it is not possible to develop a comprehensive total for imports and net sales of products from the data supplied by respondents alone as it is necessary to adjust for additional imports of products accounted for by non-reporting firms such as large industrial consumers and certain distributors which are not covered in this survey. This adjustment is accomplished through the use of import data supplied by the External Trade Section. The delay in receiving import data has in the past been responsible for holding up publication of this report for about two months over and above the time required by the respondents to file their reports. The new concept introduces a change in the method of handling import data under which the import figures supplied by respondents will be the basis of initial data with any necessary correction for full import data being made with respect to the month in which the amount of correction becomes known, rather than the month to which it applies. In effect, this means that the January figures in respect to imports and net sales as presented in this report are understated by the amount of adjustment which in the past would have normally been made through the use of full import data for January. As the latter become available they will be processed as in the past and net adjustments resulting therefrom will be incorporated into the report for a following month. In the present instance this means that the January adjustments will be included in either the February or March report. In any event, the report for each month will carry a statement indicating the month for which changes relate. Details of full imports will be carried as usual in the appropriate table of the report but because this is the first report incorporating the new concept full import data for January are not available.

2. Opening inventory data carried in the report for January do not agree with closing inventory data shown in the December, 1957 report as during 1957 it was necessary to affect certain changes arising from the adjustments made for full imports. Any differences resulting from these adjustments were usually carried in inventory. Opening inventory figures for January, 1958 are actual volumes reported by respondents without adjustment.
