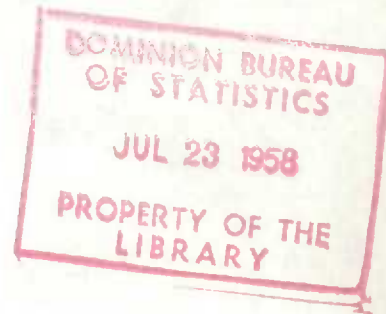

REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

May, 1958

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during May, 1958 totalled 19,730,031 barrels compared with 20,543,133 barrels in May, 1957. The total for the month under review included 6,609,583 barrels of motor gasoline, 46,350 barrels of aviation gasoline, 3,263,819 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 2,180,140 barrels of diesel fuel, 2,706,224 barrels of light fuel, 696,180 barrels of kerosene, stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil) and tractor fuel, 386,028 barrels of aviation turbo fuel, 2,841,727 barrels of naphtha specialties, and other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 18,593,221 barrels of crude oil during May, 1958, compared with 20,336,537 barrels in May, 1957. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 19,072,580 barrels, including 9,250,727 barrels of imported oil and 9,821,853 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 23,091,665 barrels compared with 22,225,607 barrels on the corresponding date of last year. These figures include stocks held at the field, in pipeline systems and in refineries.

Net sales of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from production, imports, exports, changes in inventories, etc., were as follows in May, 1958, comparable figures for corresponding month of 1957 in brackets, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons; naphtha specialties, 145,777 (143,347); aviation gasoline 337,624 (311,935), motor gasoline, 8,881,521 (8,765,703); aviation turbo fuel, 361,279 (362,616); tractor fuel, kerosene and stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 721,118 (524,628); diesel fuel, 1,968,159 (1,889,178); light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 2,285,977 (1,944,200; and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 3,419,194 (4,300,818).
