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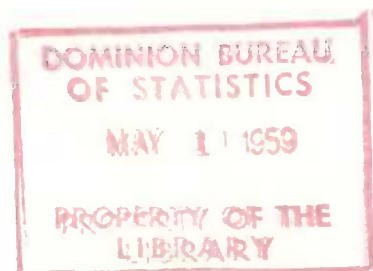

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REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

February, 1959

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during February, 1959 totalled 22,302,381 barrels compared with 19,055,206 barrels in February, 1958. The total for the month under review included 6,971,456 barrels of motor gasoline, 30,462 barrels of aviation gasoline, 4,173,467 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5, and 6), 1,508,018 barrels of diesel fuel, 4,556,718 barrels of light fuel, 1,520,281 barrels of kerosene, stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil) and tractor fuel, 273,823 barrels of aviation turbo fuel, 3,268,156 barrels of naphtha specialties, and other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 22,044,728 barrels of crude oil during February, 1959 compared with 18,902,854 barrels in February, 1958. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 22,643,462 barrels, including 9,142,265 barrels of imported oil and 13,501,197 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 23,717,608 barrels compared with 22,633,908 barrels on the corresponding date of last year. These figures include stocks held at the field, in pipeline systems and in refineries.

Net sales of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from production, imports, exports, changes in inventories, etc., were as follows in February, 1959, comparable figures for corresponding month of 1958 in brackets, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons; naphtha specialties, 97,482 (104,514); aviation gasoline, 269,898 (293,570); motor gasoline, 5,832,724 (5,584,519); aviation turbo fuel, 330,037 (279,561); tractor fuel, kerosene and stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 2,399,477 (2,190,537); diesel fuel, 1,554,426 (1,346,689); light fuel oil (nos. 2 and 3), 9,380,843 (7,787,201); and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 4,166,145 (3,481,760).

Explanatory Notes

- Note:
1. Effective January and June 1958 the reports in this series reflect a major change in concept involving the treatment of import data - see "Explanatory Notes" in January and June 1958 reports for details.
 2. Import totals shown in Table 3 were developed from actual data supplied by respondents in February with an adjustment involving December data supplied by the External Trade Section.
 3. Because of revisions opening inventory totals for the month under review do not agree with closing inventory shown on January report.
