REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

MARCH - 1959

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during March, 1959, totalled 23,376,281 barrels compared with 18,950,090 barrels in March, 1958. The total for the month under review included 7,817,678 barrels of motor gasoline, 66,386 barrels of aviation gasoline, 4,214,588 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5, and 6), 2,358,620 barrels of diesel fuel, 4,012,702 barrels of light fuel, 1,472,301 barrels of kerosene, stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil) and tractor fuel, 497,209 barrels of aviation turbo fuel, 2,936,797 barrels of naphtha specialties, and other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 23,161,557 barrels of crude oil during March, 1959 compared with 18,818,583 barrels in March, 1958. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 22,476,089 barrels, including 9,396,498 barrels of imported oil and 13,079,591 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 22,938,902 barrels compared with 22,314,116 barrels on the corresponding date of last year. These figures include stocks held at the field, in pipeline systems and in refineries.

Net sales of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from production, imports, exports, changes in inventories, etc., were as follows in March, 1959, comparable figures for corresponding month of 1958 in brackets, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons; naphtha specialties, 119,183 (120,024); aviation gasoline, 243,644 (225,926); motor gasoline, 6,335,002 (6,098,339); aviation turbo fuel, 368,678 (293,611); tractor fuel, kerosene and stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 1,935,112 (1,469,888); diesel fuel, 1,669,100 (1,508,406); light fuel oil (nos. 2 and 3), 7,231,139 (5,632,057); and heavy fuel oil (nos. 4, 5 and 6), 3,588,063 (3,075,040).
