REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

MARCH, 1960

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during March, 1960 totalled 23,280,286 barrels compared with 23,376,281 barrels in March, 1959. The total for the month under review included 7,987,202 barrels of motor gasoline, 106,636 barrels of aviation gasoline, 3,985,123 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 2,477,857 barrels of diesel fuel, 4,028,631 barrels of light fuel, 1,390,800 barrels of kerosene, stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil) and tractor fuel, 356,705 barrels of aviation turbo fuel, 2,947,332 barrels of naphtha specialties and other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 22,859,751 barrels of crude oil during March, 1960 compared with 23,161,557 barrels in March, 1959. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 22,807,415 barrels, including 9,280,644 barrels of imported oil and 13,526,771 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude held at refineries at the end of the month amounted to 8,869,992 barrels.

Net sales of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from production, imports, exports, changes in inventories, etc., were as follows in March, 1960, comparable figures for corresponding month of 1959 in brackets, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons; naphtha specialties, 130,362 (119,183); aviation gasoline, 251,158 (243,644); motor gasoline, 6,944,212 (6,428,161); aviation turbo fuel, 403,906 (368,678); tractor fuel, kerosene and stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 2,307,801 (1,952,452); diesel fuel, 1,904,894 (1,669,100); light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 8,751,708 (7,272,221); and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 4,370,596 (3,588,063).

 2. Import totals shown in Table 3 were developed from actual data supplied by respondents in March with an adjustment involving January data supplied by the External Trade Section.

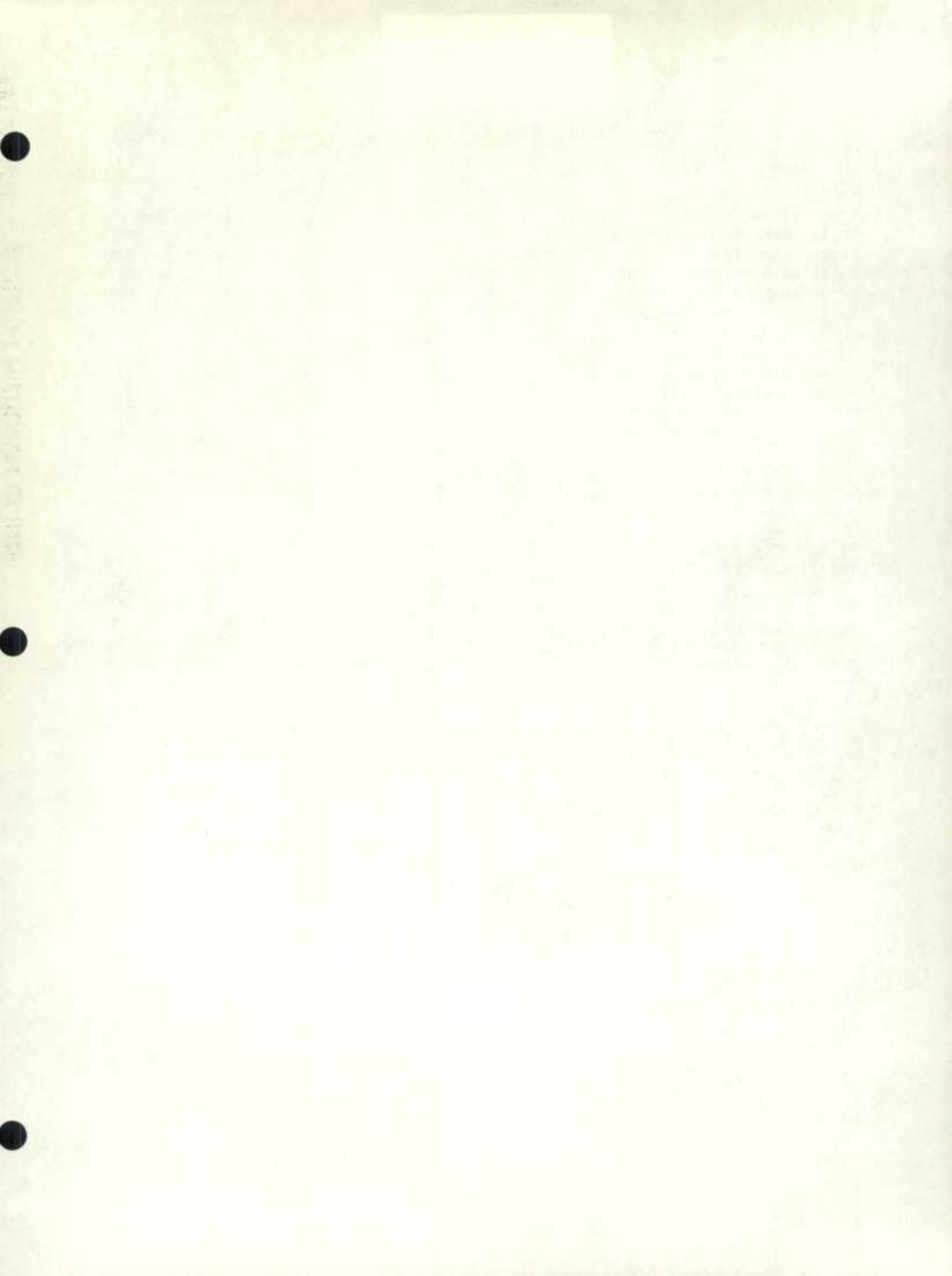
