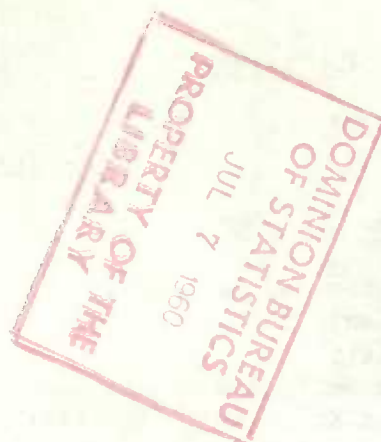

REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

April, 1960

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during April, 1960 totalled 20,583,158 barrels compared with 19,478,498 barrels in April, 1959. The total for the month under review included 7,459,789 barrels of motor gasoline, 86,015 barrels of aviation gasoline, 3,762,846 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 2,440,683 barrels of diesel fuel, 3,554,814 barrels of light fuel, 1,043,450 barrels of kerosene, stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil) and tractor fuel, 329,218 barrels of aviation turbo fuel 1,906,343 barrels of naphtha specialties, and other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 20,398,522 barrels of crude oil during April, 1960 compared with 19,257,484 barrels in April, 1959. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 19,733,281 barrels, including 8,392,783 barrels of imported oil and 11,340,498 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude held at refineries at the end of the month amounted to 8,377,818 barrels.

Net sales of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from production, imports, exports, changes in inventories, etc., were as follows in April, 1960, comparable figures for corresponding month of 1959 in brackets, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons; naphtha specialties, 155,467 (122,425); aviation gasoline, 244,944 (255,908); motor gasoline, 7,115,036 (7,392,929); aviation turbo fuel, 326,185 (348,157); tractor fuel, kerosene and stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 1,041,933 (1,248,951); diesel fuel, 1,775,913 (1,756,302); light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 4,698,802 (4,865,920); and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 3,815,319 (3,765,693).

Explanatory Notes

Note:

1. Effective January and June 1958 the reports in this series reflect a major change in concept involving the treatment of import data - see "Explanatory Notes" in January and June 1958 reports for details.
2. Import totals shown in Table 3 were developed from actual data supplied by respondents in April, with an adjustment involving February data supplied by the External Trade Section.

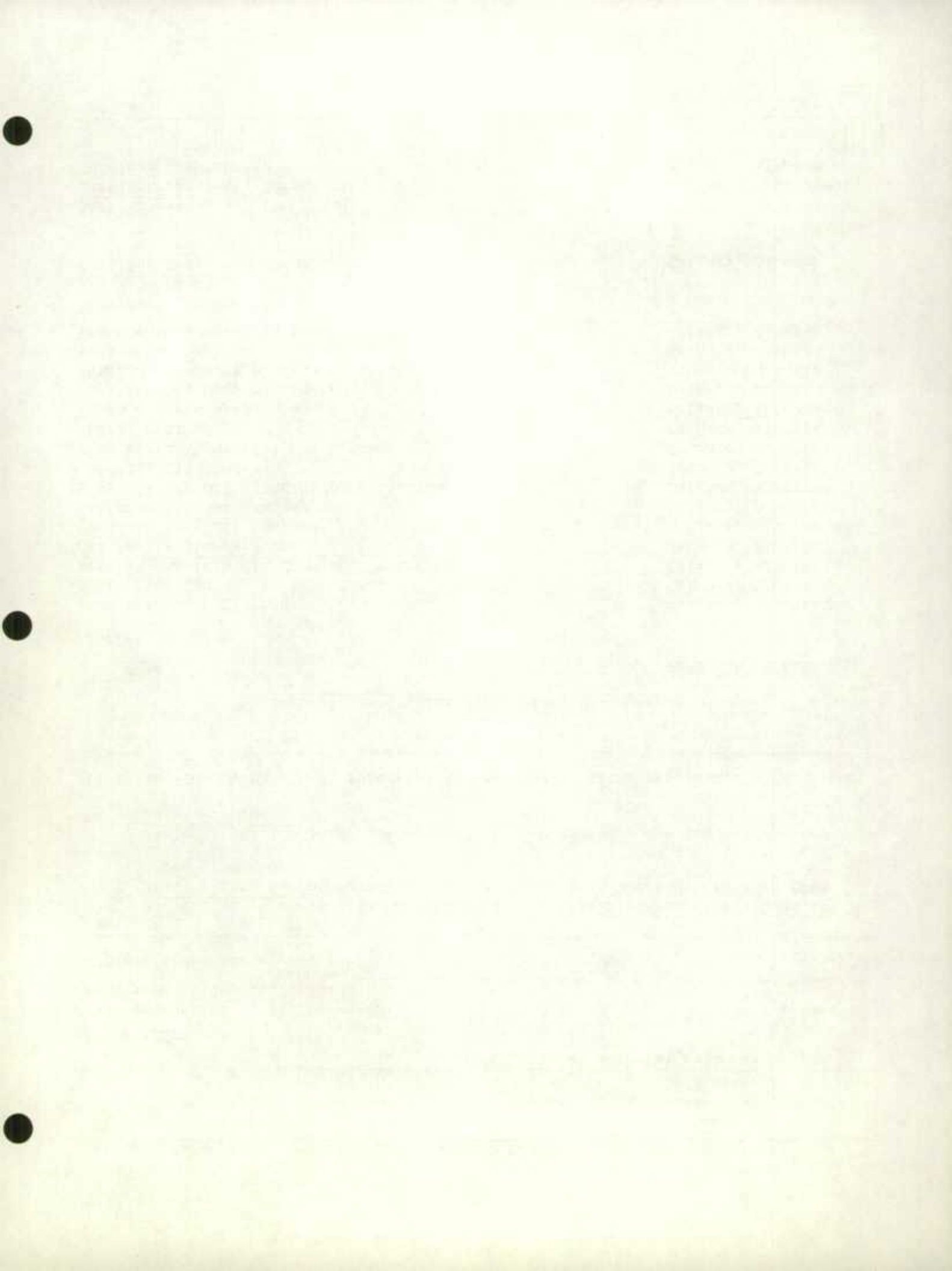
