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

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TABLE 1, NEW SUPPLY AND DISPOSITION OF CRUDE OIL AND EQUIVALENT, BY SOURCE

As indicated in the notes included in the January and February issues of this report, this is a new table designed to show the supply and disposition of (a) Canadian crude oil and equivalent, by province of origin, from its production to its delivery to both domestic and export markets, and (b) foreign crude oil and equivalent entering Canada. It is essential to recognize that, in contrast to the usual presentation, the table does not represent the supply and disposition of crude oil and equivalent within particular geographic areas.

The basic data are derived from three main sources:

Provincial Governments: Domestic production, deliveries to refineries, deliveries to other purchasers, field and plant inventories, field and plant use.

Pipeline Companies: Deliveries to refineries, transporters' inventories, pipeline fuel, exports by pipeline.

Refineries: Refinery receipts.

Ideally, the data presented in this table should agree in their entirety with those published by provincial governments. From a practical standpoint, however, certain differences in concept prevent such agreement. For example, Alberta and Saskatchewan currently publish data on oil moving eastward by pipeline based on deliveries made by the Interprovincial Pipe Line Company, regardless of whether these deliveries are made direct to refineries or to connecting pipelines. Table 1, on the other hand, records all deliveries at the refinery gate in the province of receipt, thereby ensuring agreement with refinery receipts in tables 2 and 3. These differences in point of measurement account for the lack of agreement not only in deliveries but in transporters' inventories as published in Table 1 and in provincial reports. It is hoped that these and other relatively small differences in reporting by various suppliers and publishers of data will be even further reduced.

Although most items are self-explanatory, a few require clarification. Imports are, in effect, a derived figure, representing the sum of actual deliveries to refineries by pipeline and tanker, pipeline inventory changes, losses and adjustments. Field and plant inventories are located in the province of origin. However, transporters' inventories of Canadian crude oil and equivalent are the total of pipeline fill and inventories in tanks held in both Canada and the United States. Transporters' inventories of foreign crude represent the total held in Canada by pipelines. Losses and adjustments are the balancing item, incorporating all losses and adjustments reported by both producers and transporters together with any adjustments necessary to bring disposition into balance with supply.
