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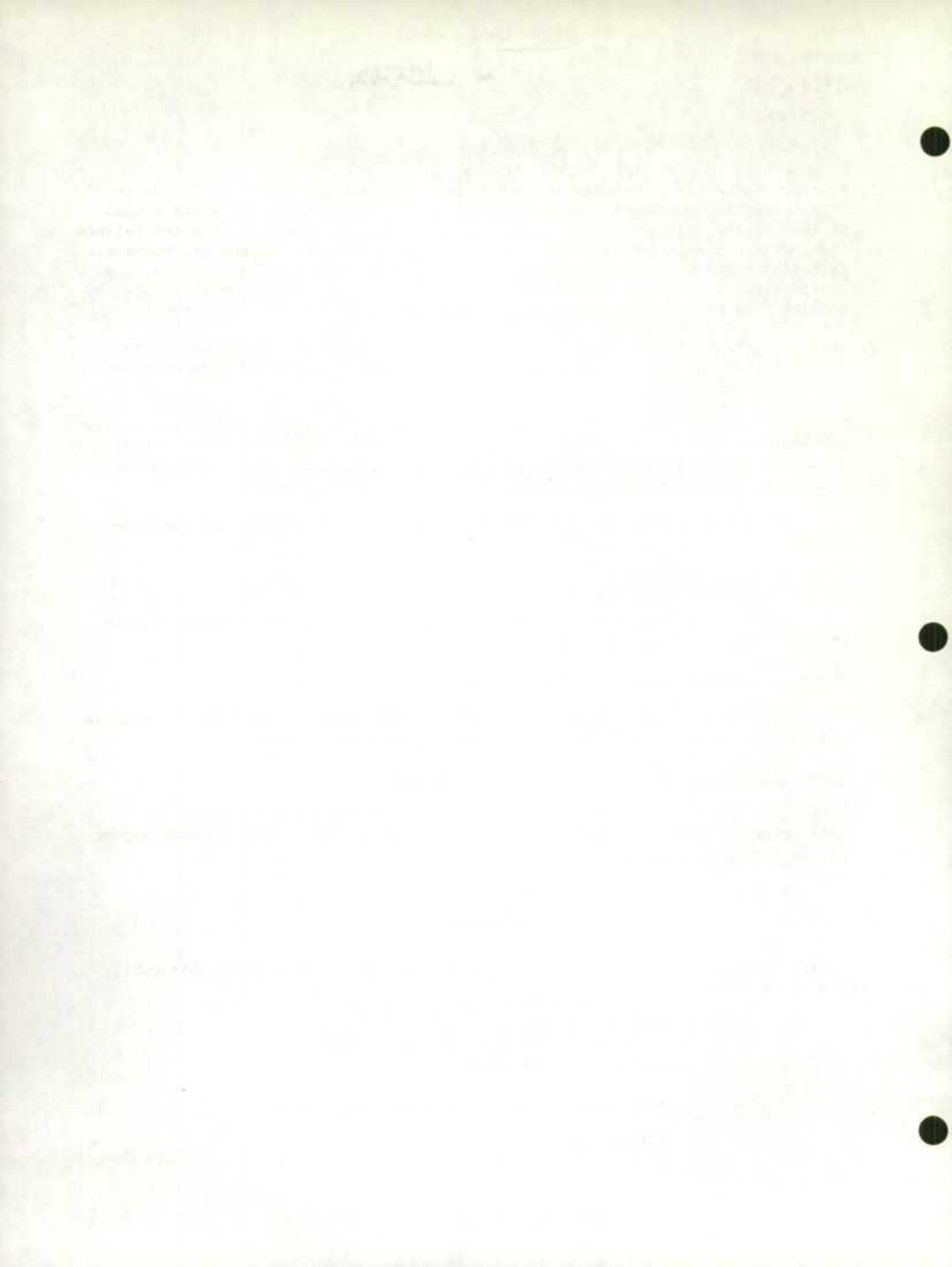
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NOTES

1. Receipts in Canada from other reporting companies and Deliveries in Canada to other reporting companies should be in balance. During the first three months of 1964, these figures were in close balance and were revised to an exact balance along with other appropriate adjustments. During the past few months, however, in spite of extensive resurveys, these two items have been out of balance by a considerable amount. In the interests of timeliness, it is now necessary to publish this report with the above items out of balance.
2. We are aware of the discrepancies that are appearing in the "Transfers-Inter-provincial-in and out". They will be corrected when the amended figures have been made available to us.
3. Due to a change in concept, the propane, butanes and propane/butane mixes supply and disposition page of this publication has been modified. The major revision has been the inclusion of the entire supply and disposition of gas processing plants and storage cavern operations.

The previous six months of 1964 will be similarly revised and when completed, will be issued to subscribers.

Item "C", page 6 - Receipts in Canada from gas processing plants:

This item in the provinces of Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia now reflects total plant production.

Items "g" and "h", page 6 - Inventories:

These items in the provinces of Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia now include inventories held at plants and in storage caverns.

Item "q", page 6 - Net sales in Canada:

This item in the provinces of Saskatchewan and Alberta now includes deliveries of butane commingled in the crude stream. The actual amounts appear at the bottom of page 6.
