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MONTHLY REPORT ON REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS IN CANADA

FEBRUARY, 1946

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during February, 1946 amounted to 4,006,161 barrels compared with 3,720,341 barrels in the corresponding month of last year. The total for the month under review included 1,796,157 barrels of motor gasoline; 29,777 barrels of aviation gasoline; 1,125,880 barrels of heavy fuel oils; 506,110 barrels of light fuel oils; 183,136 barrels of kerosene; 42,935 barrels of tractor distillate; 56,295 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 267,871 barrels of other refinery products, such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 4,376,053 barrels of crude oil in February, 1946, this being 10 per cent more than in February of last year. Receipts of crude during the current month totalled 3,990,627 barrels, including 3,411,708 barrels of imported oil and 578,559 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at refineries at the end of the month amounted to 3,538,709 barrels, this being nearly 9 per cent more than the amount held on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments, imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories, was as follows in February, 1946, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: naphtha specialties 67,316; aviation gasoline 39,248; motor gasoline 1,499,082; tractor distillate 12,676; kerosene and stove oil 299,593; light fuel oils 844,441; and heavy fuel oils 1,276,790.

According to official statistics as compiled from customs' invoices, the imports into Canada included the following items in February, 1946, all figures in barrels: crude oil for refining 3,047,030; kerosene 34,571; engine distillate 196; fuel oil, ex-warehoused for ships' stores 22,514; other fuel oils 157,103; casinghead gasoline 111,520; other gasoline 47,351; lubricating oils 15,869. Exports during the month included: fuel oils 91,417; gasoline and naphtha 703; and lubricating oils 302 barrels.
