MONTHLY REPORT ON REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS IN CANADA

JULY, 1946

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during July, 1946, totalled 6,071,259 barrels compared with 5,656,582 barrels in July, 1945. The total for the month under review included 2,822,135 barrels of motor gasoline, 21,933 barrels of aviation gasoline, 1,278,147 barrels of heavy fuel oils, 867,567 barrels of light fuel oils, 223,171 barrels of kerosene and stove oil, 170,231 barrels of tractor distillate, 40,262 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 647,813 barrels of other refinery products, such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 6,422,547 barrels of crude oil in July, 1946, compared with 6,412,989 barrels in July, 1945. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 6,410,793 barrels, including 5,807,478 barrels of imported oil and 603,315 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at refineries at the end of the month amounted to 4,112,181 barrels compared with 5,070,469 barrels held on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments, imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories, was as follows in July, 1946, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: naphtha specialties, 66,513; aviation gasoline, 57,019; motor gasoline, 3,516,923; tractor distillate, 166,780; kerosene and stove oil, 133,965; light fuel oils, 554,730; and heavy fuel oils, 1,561,524.

According to official statistics as compiled from customs' invoices, the imports into Canada included the following items in July, 1946, all figures in barrels: crude oil for refining, 5,937,343; kerosene, 53,810; engine distillate, 3,851; fuel oil exwarehoused for ships' stores, 31,175; other fuel oils, 199,839; casinghead gasoline, 136,566; other gasoline, 282,825; lubricating oils, 28,572. Exports during the month included: fuel oils, 29,252; gasoline and naphtha, 75,498; and lubricating oils, 17,000 barrels.
