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MONTHLY REPORT OF REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS IN CANADA

JANUARY - 1949

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during January, 1949, totalled 6,278,713 barrels compared with 5,706,474 barrels in January, 1948. The total for the month under review included 2,870,521 barrels of motor gasoline, 43,128 barrels of aviation gasoline, 1,693,891 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 446,961 barrels of diesel fuel, 459,704 barrels of light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 358,562 barrels of stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 36,353 barrels of tractor fuel, 79,456 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 356,480 barrels of other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc..

Refineries in Canada used 7,152,575 barrels of crude oil during January, 1949, compared with 6,244,381 barrels in January, 1948. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 5,991,307 barrels including 4,716,195 barrels of imported oil and 1,275,112 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the refineries at the end of the month amounted to 4,956,179 barrels compared with 2,965,099 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments and from imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories of refiners, wholesalers and major industrial consumers was as follows in January, 1949, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: naphtha specialties, 65,440; aviation gasoline, 81,812; motor gasoline, 2,184,220; tractor fuel, 9,012; kerosene, 104,579; stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 670,579; diesel fuel, 596,529; light fuel oil (nos. 2 and 3), 1,252,638; and heavy fuel oil, (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 1,640,624.
