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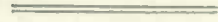

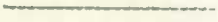

of
REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS IN CANADA

FEBRUARY - 1949

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during February, 1949, totalled 5,848,860 barrels compared with 5,151,516 barrels in February, 1948. The total for the month under review included 2,690,227 barrels of motor gasoline, 20,181 barrels of aviation gasoline, 1,501,083 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 443,273 barrels of diesel fuel, 478,921 barrels of light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 416,656 barrels of stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 43,306 barrels of tractor fuel, 80,472 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 340,070 barrels of other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc..

Refineries in Canada used 6,143,671 barrels of crude oil during February, 1949, compared with 5,552,700 barrels in February, 1948. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 5,832,794 barrels including 4,525,592 barrels of imported oil and 1,307,202 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the refineries at the end of the month amounted to 4,645,302 barrels compared with 2,636,442 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments and from imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories of refiners, wholesalers and major consumers was as follows in February, 1949, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: Naphtha specialties, 62,503; aviation gasoline, 79,486; motor gasoline, 2,141,261; tractor fuel, 9,966; kerosene, 94,855; stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 628,877; diesel fuel, 599,165; light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 1,186,479; and heavy fuel oil, (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 1,566,926.
