REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS IN CANADA

MAY - 1949

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during May, 1949, totalled 8,712,967 barrels compared with 7,162,205 barrels in May, 1948. The total for the month under review included 3,917,710 barrels of motor gasoline, 19,954 barrels of aviation gasoline, 1,967,663 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 651,709 barrels of diesel fuel, 828,642 barrels of light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 337,367 barrels of stove oil (No.1 fuel oil), 182,314 barrels of tractor fuel, 76,600 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 701,671 barrels of other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 9,348,080 barrels of crude oil during May, 1949 compared with 7,858,692 barrels in May, 1948. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 9,542,958 barrels including 7,920,817 barrels of imported oil and 1,622,141 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 6,461,232 barrels compared with 4,085,941 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments and from imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories of refiners, wholesalers and major consumers was as follows in May, 1949, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: naphtha specialties, 81,097; aviation gasoline, 106,135; motor gasoline, 4,562,877; tractor fuel, 250,182; kerosene, 57,548; stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 209,650; diesel fuel, 524,637; light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 443,595; and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 1,829,670.
