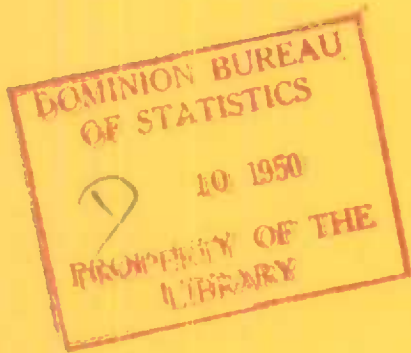

REFINED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

JANUARY - 1950

Output of refined petroleum products in Canada during January, 1950 totalled 7,324,561 barrels compared with 6,278,713 barrels in January, 1949. The total for the month under review included 3,320,331 barrels of motor gasoline, 11,124 barrels of aviation gasoline, 1,723,102 barrels of heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 470,708 barrels of diesel fuel, 908,191 barrels of light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 379,467 barrels of stove oil (No. 1 fuel oil), 5,188 barrels of tractor fuel, 80,792 barrels of naphtha specialties, and 378,118 barrels of other refinery products such as lubricating oils, asphalt, coke, liquefied petroleum gases, etc.

Refineries in Canada used 7,866,851 barrels of crude oil during January, 1950 compared with 7,152,575 barrels in January, 1949. Receipts of crude oil during the current month totalled 6,329,459 barrels including 4,540,613 barrels of imported oil and 1,788,846 barrels from Canadian sources of supply. Inventories of crude at the end of the month amounted to 4,464,929 barrels compared with 4,956,179 barrels on the corresponding date of last year.

The consumption of liquid petroleum fuels in Canada, as computed from refinery shipments and from imports, exports and changes in marketing inventories of refiners, wholesalers and major consumers, was as follows in January, 1950, all figures being in barrels of 35 Imperial gallons: Naphtha specialties, 74,497; aviation gasoline, 87,755; motor gasoline, 2,535,707; tractor fuel, 15,443; kerosene, 119,880; stove oil (No.1 fuel oil), 992,860; diesel fuel, 836,563; light fuel oil (Nos. 2 and 3), 1,458,468; and heavy fuel oil (Nos. 4, 5 and 6), 1,817,519.

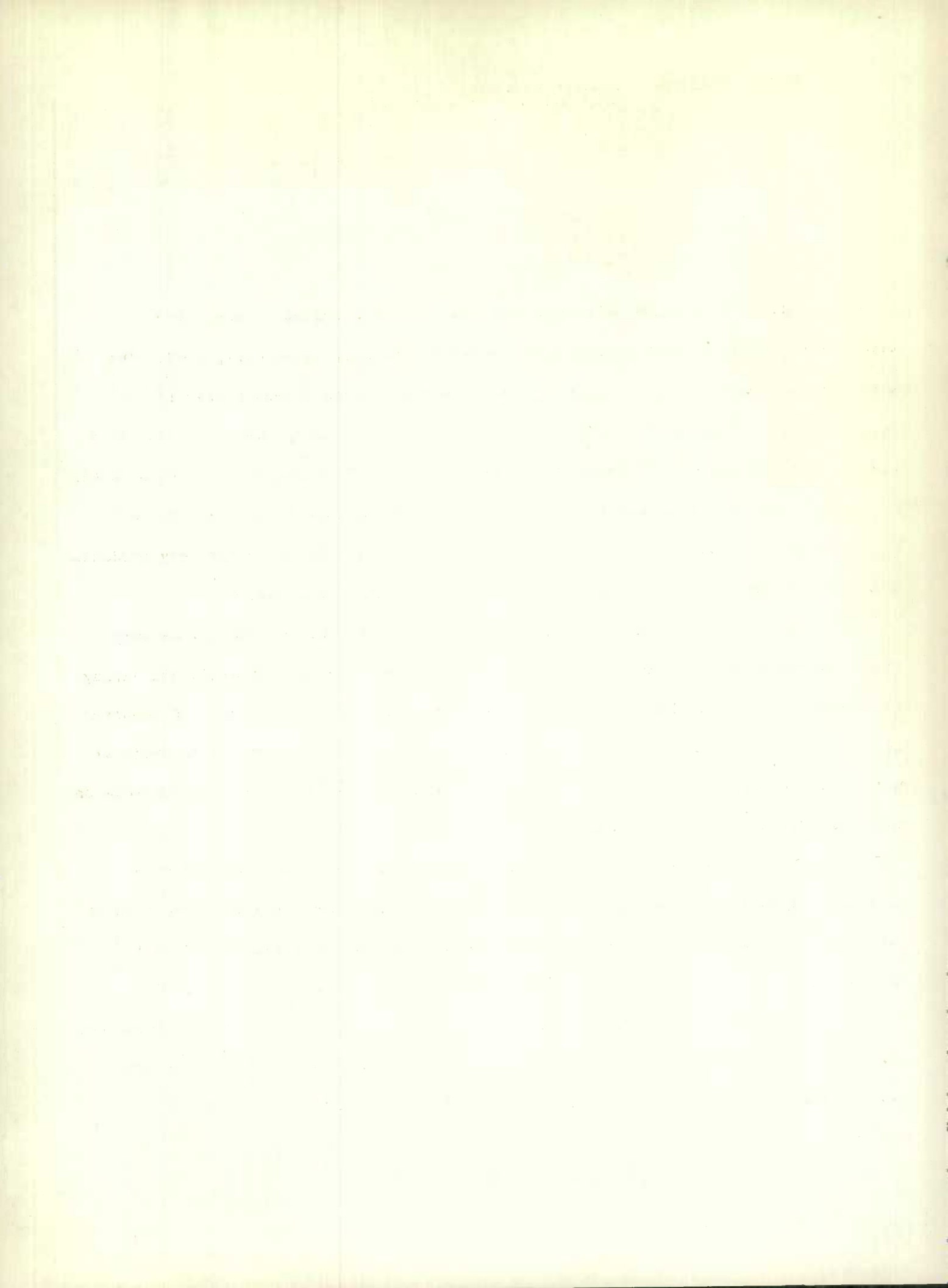

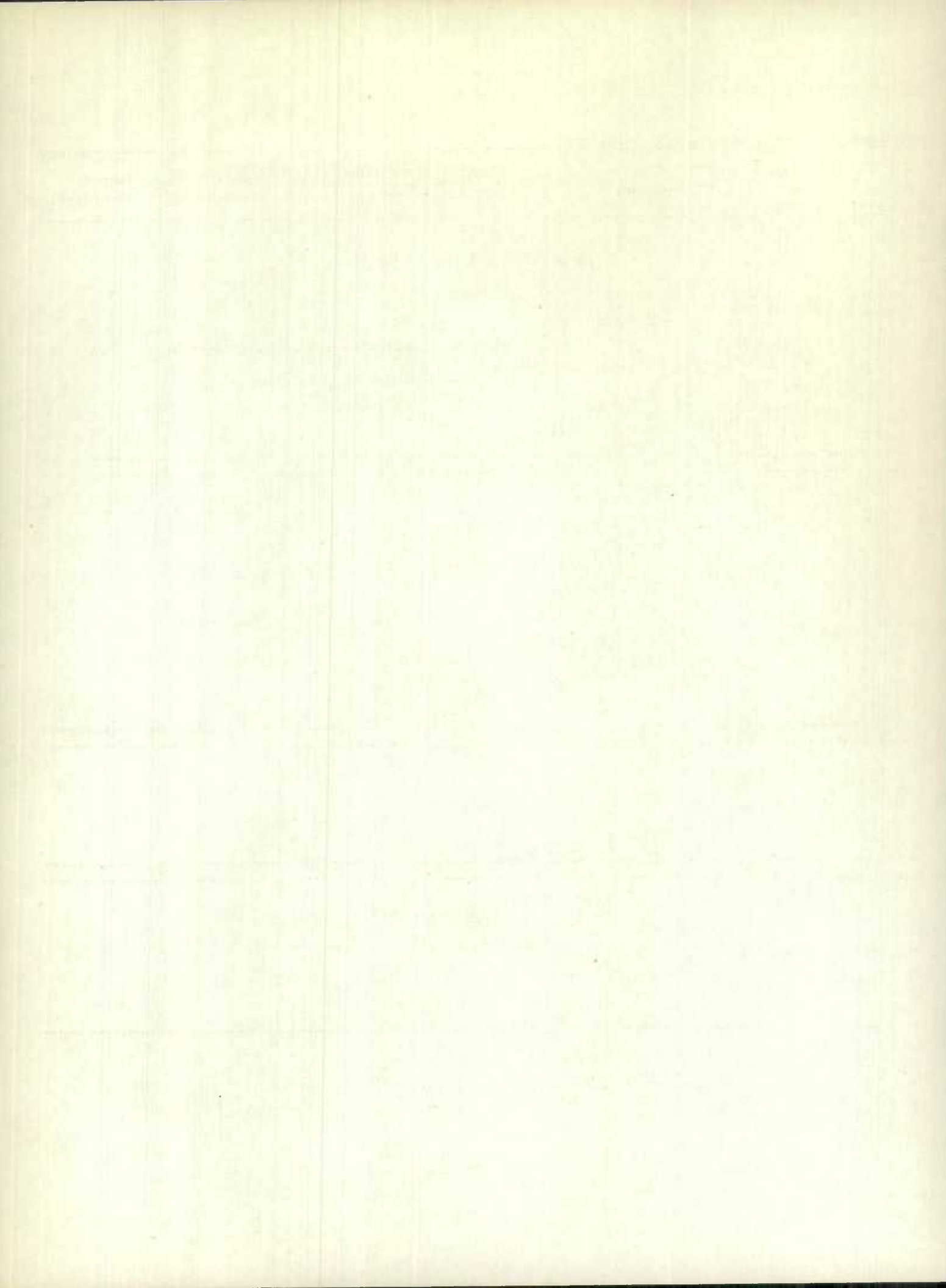
